Easter people—how shall we bear the fruit of Love?


**We will love in our rest, play, work, worship,

CHILDREN'S MESSAGE



In this is love, not that we loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins.

He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes[a] to make it bear more fruit.

You have already been cleansed by the word that I have spoken to you.

Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me.

I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing.

Whoever does not abide in me is thrown away like a branch and withers; such branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned.

If you abide in me and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.
